John 16:4-15


I have told you this, so that when their time comes you will remember that I warned you about them. I did not tell you this from the beginning because I was with you, but now I am going to him who sent me. None of you asked me, 'Where are you going?' Rather, you are filled with grief because I have said these things. But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. When he comes, he will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment: about sin, because people do not believe in me; about righteousness because I am going to the Father where you can see me no longer and about judgement because the prince of this world now stands condemned. I have much more to say to you, more than you can now bear. But, when the Spirit of truth comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own, he will speak only what he hears and he will tell you what is yet to come. He will glorify me because it is from me that he will receive what he will make known to you. All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what he will make known to you.

"Jesus explained to the disciples that God is sending the Holy Spirit and they will receive power from the Holy Spirit to be able to do things they normally would not be able to do. With this power Jesus told them to go out, spread the Gospel and build churches. Because Jesus died for us and rose from the dead we too have access to the Holy Spirit and are able to do great works," said Pastor Howell.

HEALTHY TRAVEL
